- March 31, 2006 : Deadline for receipt of one-page abstract. Use the attached form and send it to the conference secretary or coordinator of each country.
- May 31, 2006 : Notice to authors for acceptance with instructions for preparation of camera-ready manuscript to be published in the proceedings.
- September 20, 2006 : Deadline for receipt of camera-reader manuscript in final version for the proceedings to the secretary of the conference.
- October 20, 2006 : Deadline for receipt of manuscript to the secretary for review according to the format of each international journal.
- November 26, 2006 : Publication of proceedings and Registration.
- December 31, 2006 : Notice to authors for acceptance for publication in each international journal.
- In the Middle of 2007 : Publication of special issue of each international journal.

## **Conference Fee**
